The Tennessee Association of Special Programs (TASP) is pleased to announce its annual scholarship competition. TRIO participants are invited to compete for Adult Learner Scholarship awards of \$400.00. These awards may be used to help defray postsecondary educational costs during the academic year.

Enclosed are application materials needed to apply for these scholarships along with a list of current TASP individual and institutional members. The application can also be downloaded on TASP's website at <http://www.tasptrio.org>. **Only one application may be submitted per TRIO program. Institutions which have more than one program (e.g. Student Support Service, Educational Opportunity Center, Veterans Upward Bound, and McNair Scholars, Educational Talent Search (ETS participants age 19 and older)) may submit an application for each project. Sponsors of applicants MUST BE CURRENT MEMBERS OF TASP as well as their respective institutions. Refer to the list of TASP's individual and institutional members to ensure your membership is current or contact Mark Cotter, mccotter@pstcc.edu.**

***NOTE:** Institutions/agencies that send more than one application from the same program will be disqualified.*

Applicants will be judged and rated in the following areas (see **Rating Rubric for Detailed Point Values**):

Please be sure to go over the applications with your students for accuracy and completion before submitting

1. Essay (content, grammar, format, etc.) (50 points)
2. Academic performance/scholarship (10 points)
3. Two recommendation letters (10 points)
4. Leadership, school activities, and community volunteer service (20 points)
5. TRIO activities (10 points)

Each application will be reviewed and rated by the TASP Scholarship Committee. No applicant's materials will be reviewed by a person from the same college, university, or agency.

Applicants and their sponsors will be notified of results by the end of **May 2016**. The names and schools of winners will be announced at the Student Initiatives and on TASP's website (www.tasptrio.org).

In order for winners to receive their awards, students must provide official verification of FALL 2016 enrollment in a postsecondary institution by **September 30, 2016 to Mark Cotter. Award checks will be issued during the fall semester and made payable to the student.**

TASP ADULT LEARNER 2016 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Each applicant for a TASP Adult Learner Scholarship **MUST:**

1. Have participated in one of the federally-funded TRIO programs (SSS, EOC, VUB, McNAIR, or TS (age 19 and older))
2. Be a freshman, sophomore, or junior in college with at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average; be a college senior (*only if they are planning to enroll in a graduate school program following the award announcement*); or, if not currently enrolled in school, be an individual who has met the criteria listed herein at the school last attended or has scored an average of at least 50 on the General Education Development (GED) test or 70 on the HiSet.
3. Be sponsored/recommended by a TRIO/TASP staff member of the project in which the applicant participates.
NOTE: Both the TRIO program and sponsoring staff member must be current members of TASP.

Materials that must be submitted

1. Complete an official TASP Adult Learner Scholarship Application in its entirety. Included in the application is space for a 300-word essay (maximum). **Please have student write based upon criteria outlined on the essay page.**
2. Provide an official college transcript or a GED Certificate listing official written verification of scores. *Note: an official high school transcript is to be submitted only if the applicant is not currently enrolled in college.*
3. Provide a Letter of Recommendation from the sponsoring TRIO staff member.
4. Provide a Letter of Recommendation from a school official (teacher, counselor, principal, president, dean, etc.). *A TRIO staff member may provide the second letter, only if the applicant is not currently enrolled in college.*
5. Email a picture and short bio to slangley@tusculum.edu. A short bio and picture of the winners will be posted on TASP's website (www.tasptrio.org).
